#### RESIDENTS Clean, hair tidy, shaved, odor-free Communicating with one another Involved in activities Satisfied with the care being provided FOOD Ample, nutritious, tasty Appropriate temperature Menus posted, choice of foods **STAFF** Interacting with residents in cheerful manner Promptly responding to resident's needs Promptly responding to resident's needs Adequate number to ensure proper care for all residents Administrator's availability with staff supervision and resident's needs **PHYSICAL PLANTS** Clean environment, beds made, clean and adequate supply of linens Knowledgeable of disease process and care techniques
